## Age Groups for All Classes

(see exceptions under Class Restrictions)

- Lead Line—2nd Grade & under with a handler 13 years or older
- ★ Small Fry—2nd Grade & under showing alone
- Junior—3rd through 5th Grade
- ★ Intermediate—6th through 8th Grade
- Senior—9th through12th Grade
- ★ Adult—19 to 40 years of age
- Super Senior—40 years & older

Age groups are determined by the grade completed last June.



#### **Class Restrictions**

- Lead Line & Small Fry classes are walk/trot only
- ➢ Driving classes are not open to Lead Line exhibitors
- Small Fry entering driving classes must have an adult in the cart
- In Hand gaming classes are open to horses/ponies 48" & under and/or 3 years old or younger. (exceptions may be made for special circumstances)
- Walk/trot gaming horses will receive a 5 second penalty each time the horse breaks into a canter.
- Walk/Trot classes are not divided by age group.
- Bareback classes are not open to Lead Line or Small Fry.
- Each horse/exhibitor combination may enter a class only once.
- Exhibitors entering a walk/trot class may not enter the regular version of that class.
- Age groups may be combined in the ring, but will be judged separately.
